Transcript of records (TOR)	The grading scale goes from 0 to 100; minimum grade required to pass being 60. Students must attend at least 80% of classes in order to pass the course. The TORs will be sent to the international office of the home university once the academic cycle has ended.

Research stays / Internships	The acceptance for research and internships is subject to the approval of the corresponding University Center.
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F. Other information

Medical insurance requirements	International medical coverage is required during the stay including provisions relating to the Coronavirus medical care "COVID-19" (SARS-CoV-2), coverage for detection, monitoring, and treatment, as well as; -repatriation of remains; -medical transfer and/or repatriation for accident , coalesce, disease; Medical, assistance for accident; -medical assistance for NON-preexisting disease; - psychological assistance
Cost of the stay	The estimated cost of living is between 500 and 700 US dollars a month. Additional costs should be taken into consideration for unexpected occurrences.
Accommodation	There are no residences provided by the university; therefore, students will have to look for their own accommodation.
Buddy program	The University Center of Economic and Administrative Sciences (CUCEA) a "Buddy program" to guide exchange students.
Airport pick-up	Not available.
Scholarships for exchange students	Not available.
