How to join?

Admission requirements:

Applicants should be currently enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's program at one of our partner universities. They should have a good knowledge of English, as the course is taught in English. Prior knowledge of Social Entrepreneurship is not necessary. The two weeks course bears 3 ECTS.





Application: deadline - April 8th, 2018

Your application should include:

- Proof of international health insurance
- Proof of matriculation
- Information on level of German (if applicable)
- Proof of command of English level (B1)

Course fee: 700 EUR / 1000 EUR*
